

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Each year Bishop and Mrs. Reddick gift to the clergy of the Eighth Episcopal District the Upper Room Daily Meditation - "Disciplines". The content of this month's pastor's message is taken from the meditations from April 22nd and 23rd, 2024. Spring is burgeoning and we are approaching the dog days of summer. Our youth are in the midst of testing periods in school and end of school year activities. Our church is preparing for the Connectional Youth and Young Adult Conference and we here in the 8th Episcopal District will host the Unity Summit later this summer. We are making our move through, yet another year God has blessed us to move, live and have our being. So much of the Christian life is about being on the journey with others and discerning the wise path to take through life. For those of us who profess ourselves to be disciples of God, we must constantly strive to discern the will of God for our daily living. Rarely do we receive explicit instructions along the way; however, in Acts 8:26-28, Philip did. He was told exactly what to do in verse 26. We are often halt between two opinions, and sometimes each is equally good. It is here we can get caught up in space of worrying about which way to go or how to go. Let us all remember what the apostle Paul said in Acts 17:28, "In him we live and move and have our being". I encourage each of us, particularly our youth, as you move out into the summer, with all of its enticements, to live, move and have your being following the will of God - live in the spirit, and by the spirit. Yes, even let the spirit make intercession for you - when you don't know what to do, seek God for direction through prayer and meditation. Young people, this summer, you are going to be encountering numerous people. Philip gives us a beautiful image of what it means to be on a journey with another and to hear the word of God in new ways. Verses 29 through 40 of chapter 8, show us Philip joining the Ethiopian eunuch on his path. Notice and remember he was told by the angel of the Lord what to do, and he allowed himself to be led by the Lord in how he did it. He did not barge in and onto the Ethiopian eunuch's chariot, telling the eunuch what to do - no he let the eunuch lead the way. Philip waited to be invited into the chariot, and then he asked the eunuch what he was reading, and if he understood what he was reading. Even after bringing some clarity, Philip didn't instruct the eunuch on what to do next, but rather allowed the eunuch to discover what God had in store for his future. "Here is water; what is to prevent me from being baptized."

As each of you go forward, I encourage you to pray and meditate to hear and discern the will of God for your advancement; and then let us all focus on how we shall be with one another - shall we talk at one another or be led by God to join one another on the journey of discovery to a bright and new existence with God. God is speaking, shall we hear, not let us only hear, but listen, and then not only listen but understand and be the children of God we are called to be!


